

THE U-TURN "STORY" - MBCPS

- Facilitating MBCPs and seeing high levels of AOD use, missed opportunities & glaring gaps in content.
- The need for "targeted interventions" higher functioning men no generalised violence.
- A more holistic view of men who have used FV.
- A need for evidenced-based behaviour change interventions and strategies.
- Royal Commission FV recommendations 87, 92 & 93 acknowledged the need for programs addressing the AOD – FV intersection.





THE U-TURN "STORY" -STAKEHOLDERS



- Regular meetings & conversations with <u>Magistrate Goldsbrough</u> Regional Coordinating Magistrate
 @ Moorabbin Courts.
- Meetings with VicPol, Monash University, Corrections & Department of Health (AOD) representatives.
- Department of Health funded a 12 month pilot (2 x programs) with eval included.
- Pilot & evaluation were extend (24 months 4 x programs).







ASSESSMENT CRITERIA - COHORT

APPROPRIATE	NOT APPROPRIATE
Employed/employable	Unemployed/Unemployable
Reasonably stable accommodation	Long term homeless
Little/no criminal history	High levels of recidivism/extensive criminal record
Perceived capacity for change	Limited capacity for change
Desire to address substance use	Chronic substance dependence
Desire to avoid prison	Not concerned with "doing time"
Strong English-speaking capabilities	Low command of English & literacy
Reasonable levels of insight	Low levels of insight
No detectible ABI/cognitive impairment	Diagnosed (or suspected) ABI/cognitive impairment
No detectable complex Mental Health issues	Complex Mental Health issues







THE U-TURN PROGRAM OVERVIEW


- An early intervention program for men (18+ years).
- Men's Behaviour Change Program style program (MBCP) for male respondents on interim and final IVO's where AOD have been present, either historically or currently. Applicant/AFM can be anyone in the "family" – all referrals received from Moorabbin Courts.
- Delivered across 15 weeks, in <u>closed group sessions (3 x 1-hour orientation sessions and 12 x 2-hours intensive sessions = 27-hour dosage)</u>
- Targeting higher functioning men who have had little to no prior involvement with the justice/criminal justice system (low to medium risk FV).
- U-Turn adherers to all MBCP minimum standards except for program duration (MBCPs go for 20 weeks).
- Involves regular family safety contact.







THE U-TURN EVALUATION



- Headed by Associate Professor Silke Meyer
- 24 months: 2019-2021 (4 x programs)
- Qualitive & Quantitative data
- Self-repots from participants & AFMs, court data
- · Interviews with stakeholders
- Reductions in verbal, physical & sexual FV
- Improved parenting, emotional regulation & empathy
- Reductions in AOD misuse
- No reported IVO breaches, 12 month follow up













FEMINIST SOCIOLOGICAL FRAMEWORK

- U-Turn acknowledges all behaviour exists within a sociological context.
- U-Turn utilises a feminist framework to explain the division of power through gender roles & social inequity.
- A sociological framework is not a clinical intervention.
- U-Turn employs evidenced-based behaviour change interventions informed by a feminist framework.







U-TURN PROGRAM CONTENT

- Explores the impacts of male family violence on women and children.
- Offers a comprehensive overview of the Family Law act, definitions & categories of FV and gendered nature of FV.
- Addresses AOD mis/use through a harm minimisation framework.
- Explicitly teaches emotional regulation and emotional literacy (utilising a CBT framework).
- Has a strong philosophical focus on personal responsibility (employs an Existential lens).







U-TURN PROGRAM CONTENT

- Examines disparity between Intent Vs Impact.
- Explores trauma & attachment across the lifespan including the impacts of violence on children.
- Analyses the family of origin including gender roles & masculinity.
- Explicitly teaches empathy, communication skills, radical acceptance & the importance of gratitude.
- Psycho-educational approach to mental health & the C.N.S







THE U-TURN STORY SO FAR...

- 24 month evaluation.
- 10 x programs delivered: **59 of 74 men completed 80% completion (forensic AOD program).**
- Currently delivering U-Turn 11 intake open for U-Turn 12.
- Funded until June 2023.
- Plans for expansion.
