Problems: the importance of identifying and addressing the problem

When the problem is defined for you

- Telling us what you know even if you think we might know it
- Localising the problem let us know how things are different for your area,
 and what that means for your program
- Engaging with all the components of the problem don't leave us hanging

When you define the problem

- Evidencing the problem and evidencing your solution don't assume we know all about it
- Storytelling about problems give the problem a human face

Persuading: hooking into strategic agendas and priority cohorts to maximise your chances of success

It's what you know

- Painting a vivid picture who will be using their service and how will things be different?
- Content is not the only expertise tell us about strategy
- Asking questions, especially when timelines are tight and especially if something doesn't seem right

It's not what you know, it's who you know

- Capitalising on existing relationships and how they will be part of the service
- Success stories and the importance of client perspectives
