








WHAT IS ACCESS HEALTH?




















































- Approx 1300 people attend AH annually
- 23% of all contacts are by Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander People
- 59% male, 40% female, 1% non-binary/gender diverse
- Average 20 new registrations each month
 - 55% are experiencing primary homelessness
 - 90% have a diagnosed mental health condition
 - 40% are seeking to commence ORT
 - 60% have no emergency contact or next of kin
 - Primary drug of choice:
 - 40% heroin, 27% cannabis, 27% methamphetamine, 3% GHB, 3% other
 - 13% have recently released from correctional facilities
 - 50% of new service users hear about us via word of mouth from community
- When first arriving, most people are seeking AOD services including ORT, mental health services and dental services
- St Kilda NSP:
 - 30-35,000 annual visits
 - 1.2 million needles annually




